# **SCHOOL ORGANIZATION PLANS**

Our September 2024-2025 school organization is based on projected enrolment and mandated class sizes. During the first two weeks of September the enrolment may not match the projection resulting in the need to re-organize classes. This will occur on the P.A. Day, Monday, September 16th. If re-organization of classes is required, parents will be notified by phone and with a letter Friday, September 13th.

#### SCHOOL DRIVEWAY/PARKING

We do not have a Kiss and Ride at St. Rose of Lima. Parents are **NOT TO DRIVE INTO THE SCHOOL PARKING LOT** or park as the lanes are designated for bus and fire routes only. In the interest of safety, please use the designated legal parking areas on the street to drop off and pick up your child(ren) during morning entry and afternoon dismissal. We ask that you not block access to the school driveway as it hampers the buses from entering and exiting the property. When entering school property from the street, use the sidewalks and not the driveway.

# **TRANSPORTATION UPDATES**

Transportation is provided for JK/SK and Grade 1-8 students at St. Rose of Lima who meet the Board distance eligibility for busing. At present, students are being assigned by the Transportation Department. Courtesy Seating will be available in October. Note: Flex Boundary students are not eligible for courtesy seats. #### **VALUABLES**

Students are asked not to bring valuables such as electronic games, large amounts of money or items of personal importance to school. School supplies and personal items should be clearly labelled with your child's first/last name.

# MEDICAL ALERT-ANAPHYLACTIC SHOCK-NUT ALLERGIES

This year, as in the past, we continue to have students with severe, life- threatening food allergies. This is a medical condition causing a severe reaction to certain allergens and can result in death within minutes. Although this may or may not affect your child's class directly, please send lunches and snacks to school with your child that are free from peanut or nut products. We ask that you *do not send in food products for the whole class to celebrate birthdays or special occasions like Halloween, Valentine's Day etc...* A donation of a book or a game to the classroom is a safe alternative to food products and enjoyed much longer!



# STORAGE/ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION

Parents are responsible for ensuring that all medication and forms are updated **annually** for any student who requires medication administered at school. If your child requires medication, please have the necessary forms completed and return them, along with any medication, to the office as soon as possible. Forms went home in June and are available from Mrs. Mitanis in the main office for students new to the school

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS**

As noted in the Community Information Bulletin sent by the Board to all families, we will continue to work closely with Peel Public Health to promote a safe and healthy school environment. Here in class, we will promote good hygiene habits. We ask parents to have your child stay home if they are sick, keep up to date with immunizations, and connect with staff regarding any health concerns.
